



# CEP-Eligible Schools in Maryland 2019-2020 School Year

The following Maryland schools are eligible, but not participating in the Community Eligibility Provision, or CEP. This selected list of schools are among those eligible to participate in the 2019-2020 school year.

CEP allows high poverty schools to offer free breakfast and lunch to all students – essentially becoming *Hunger-Free Schools*. More than 106,000 students in Maryland attend one of 242 *Hunger-Free Schools*.

# CEP-Eligible and Near-Eligible Schools for the 2019-2020 School Year

The following Maryland schools are eligible, but are not participating in the Community Eligibility Provision. CEP allows high poverty schools to provide free breakfast and lunch to all students – essentially becoming *Hunger-Free Schools*. More than 106,000 students in Maryland attend one of 242 *Hunger-Free Schools*.

**KEY:**

- A school is individually eligible to elect CEP if the ISP is > 40%.
- A school with an ISP > 50% is individually CEP-eligible and would receive the highest reimbursement rate for more than 75% of meals served.
- A school with an ISP between 30-40% is “near-eligible” and if therefore potentially eligible to elect CEP when grouped with other schools.
